

Co-Curricular Activities (CCA)

Can the school offer more CCA?

The school offers varied CCA to cater to the different segments, needs and interests of the student population. There are Sports & Games, Visual & Performing Arts, Clubs & Unformed Groups CCA. School reviews the offerings annually to ensure that CCA are relevant and appealing to the general population of students as well as critical mass to yield meaningful learning and economy of scale.

Can all CCA be made competitive so that more children will get the opportunity to compete?

The school participates in MOE organized opportunities for students to compete or benchmark and obtain feedback for improvement, i.e., National Sports Games (NSG) and Singapore Youth Festival (SYF) Arts Presentation. The school also considers the suitability of non-MOE organized opportunities for our students. While the school encourages and supports student participation in such opportunities, it also aims to set up students for meaningful experiences that they are ready to take part in. The school will not unduly stress students to perform beyond their capacity which could result in them feeling unduly disappointed and withdrawing from the CCA altogether.

Can the school allow students to change their CCA within a year of joining?

One of the goals of CCA is to build resilience, skills and leadership qualities in the students. It can only be done progressively and over a long period. Hence, it will not be helpful if the students change their CCA within a year.
