Dear Parents

Welcome back to Term 3! Following are some updates to note:

1. Safe Management Measures

As national measures for COVID-19 are relaxed, it is imperative that we remain vigilant, work collectively, sensibly and continually to foster in our students the right values, personal hygiene and social behaviours. Daily visual screening and temperature-taking has ceased from 4 Apr 22. In line with the revised guidelines from MOE, temperature-taking will be conducted during the first week of every term. The temperature-taking exercise for Term 3, 2022 will take place on Wed, 29 Jun 22. Notwithstanding this, we would like to seek your assistance in ensuring that your child brings a working Oral Digital Thermometer to school every day.

We bid farewell to Ms Low XL, HOD/Math, who will be joining another ministry as well as Mdm Hasnah Ahmad, CSO, who has retired and welcome our newly posted-in Ms Tan Pheck Wan, Lead Teacher/CL and Mdm Norsahida, Art Teacher.

There will be weekly school assemblies on Mondays from Term 3 onwards. When school reopens, all students will continue to arrive in school punctually and proceed straight to the hall on Mondays and classrooms from Tuesdays to Fridays. We urge students to exercise self-discipline and responsibility to be prompt for flag raising & lessons and come in to school before 7.30 am and not later. Additionally for safety, students should not arrive earlier than 7 am daily.
