Phases of P1 Registration

Child who is an International Student (IS)

Phases of P1 Registration	Eligibility	Key Dates
Phase 3	<p>For a child who is neither a Singapore Citizen (SC) nor a Permanent Resident (PR)</p> <p>Parents who wish to seek admission to P1 will be required to submit an online *‘‘indication of interest’’ form via MOE P1 website during late May or early June 25.</p> <p>*The online indication of interest (IOI) by international Student (IS) is not considered as registration. The online IOI is not first come, first served. Admission is not guaranteed as there are limited vacancies remaining for IS after places are allocated to SC / PR children. As admission is not guaranteed, parents of IS are advised to consider alternative educational options well ahead of time.</p>	<p>From: 27 May 2025 (Tue), 9.00am To: 2 Jun 2025 (Mon), 4.30pm</p> <p>Phase 3 Results Announcement: By Oct 2025, MOE will notify parents who have indicated their interest via email as to whether their non-SC / non-PR child can be offered a P1 place in a primary school.</p>

Registration Procedures

All phases of registration will be via the **P1 Registration Portal**:

- You need a valid Singpass with 2-Factor Authentication (Singpass2FA) to access the P1 Registration Portal.
- Only one parent is required to register.
- In the Registration Portal, you are required to declare that you have sought consent from the other parent to register your child for P1.

If you do not see details of your child due for P1 registration in the portal, you can register via an online form in the portal. There is no need to submit any documents unless you register via the online form.

Registration Procedures

You will need to prepare the following information for the **online form**:

1. Child's full name
2. Child's BC number
3. Child's date of birth
4. Address used for registration
5. Email
6. Contact details (Mobile number)

The school will contact you if further clarification is required.

After P1 Registration Exercise, you will also be required to produce your child's immunisation records to the school.

Registration Procedures

- **Declaration of Alternative Child-Care Arrangement**

A declaration of alternative child-care arrangement is required for parents who wish to register their child using the address of the child's grandparent or the parent's sibling and the address is within 2km from the school of choice. The eligibility criteria are:

- Both parents are working full-time at the time the declaration is made; **and**
- The child is under the care of a grandparent or a parent's sibling.

Declaration period: 30 Jun 2025 – 31 Jul 2025

Please allow at least 3 working days for your application to be processed.

You must receive the approval email from MOE before you can register your child for P1 using the caregiver's address.

Registration Procedures

- **Using the address of a new property***
 - For **HDB flat**: A copy of the Agreement For Lease (AFL), which can be downloaded from MyHDBPage.
 - For **private property**: A copy of the original Sales and Purchase agreement.
- **Using the address of a Resale Property***
 - For **HDB flat**: A printout of the resale flat status from the HDB Flat Portal. It must indicate that HDB has received your application to buy a resale flat.
 - For **private property**: The exercised Option-To-Purchase (OTP) and buyer's Stamp Duty Certificate.

** the child is required to reside at the address used for registration for **at least 30 months** from the commencement of the 2024 P1 Exercise*

Registration Procedures

- **Divorced or Separated Parents**

- During registration, you are required to declare that you have sought consent from the other parent to register your child for P1.
- Relevant court order setting out the custody arrangements pertaining to the child, signed Letter of Consent, signed Letter of Undertaking (if necessary).

Registration Procedures

- **Withdrawal from school**

- If you have secured a P1 place for your child in a previous registration phase, you will need to withdraw your place from the school before registering in another school.
- The same parent who registered the child must withdraw their place through the P1 Registration Portal successfully before registering for another school in their next eligible phase.



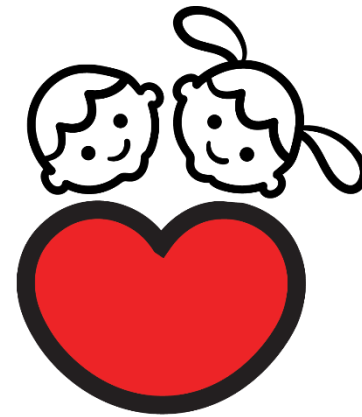
